## Grow your skills with the MDHHS Doula Rise Initiative

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Doula Initiative is offering [Doula Rise](#), a professional development opportunity designed to help Medicaid-enrolled doulas enhance their knowledge and skills.

Through Doula Rise, eligible Medicaid enrolled doulas may receive reimbursement for registration fees for qualifying professional development and continuing education training completed between Oct. 1, 2025, and Aug. 31, 2026. Eligible training topics include advanced doula skills, childbirth education, lactation support, business practices, pregnancy and infant loss support, and additional birth and postpartum education.

## Maternal-infant health initiative launched in Wayne County

Rx Kids has launched in six cities in Wayne County: River Rouge, Hamtramck, Highland Park, Inkster, Melvindale, and Dearborn.

Under the program, pregnant mothers in these communities can apply to receive \$1,500 during pregnancy and \$500 per month for the first six months of their child's life. Expectant mothers must be at least 16 weeks pregnant at the time of enrollment or have an infant born on or after Nov. 1, 2025.
